PROGRAM GOALS/outcomes

The **CPP Music Department** will:

1. Provide for the intellectual and musical growth of our students, preparing them for success in graduate and professional pursuits.

4. Nurture the creativity and artistry of musicians.

STUDENT LEARNING OUTCOMES:

Any CPP music graduate will be able to:

1. **Articulate** the many influences on any musical endeavor (e.g., cultural, artistic, technological, practical/logistic, economic, etc.).
2. **Discuss and appraise** the role of music in a balanced life and **promote** musical culture in the community.
3. **Demonstrate** collaborative skills in producing a musical event or product.
4. **Perform** a variety of music with accuracy and artistry, both solo and ensemble.
5. **Integrate and apply** an understanding of music history and styles, theory and musicianship, commerce/business, and technologies, to their area of expertise in order to identify problems, construct original ideas and draw conclusions.

In addition, the student completing the **Bachelor of Music degree** will further be able to:

1. **demonstrate** a high level of musicianship that facilitates independent preparation of music for performance/presentation.
2. **produce** a capstone project that presents an extended work or several shorter works, showing their "voice" as a performer or composer, depending on their option area.
