Daniel Pearl was an inspirational man to all who knew him. He was not just the journalist that we know of today but a highly charismatic musician who traveled the world with different bands. He was known by many and was a friend to all. Pearl started working for the *Wall Street Journal* in 1990 and in 2000 he became the South Asia Bureau Chief. He worked on the "war on terrorism" from Bombay, India but would sometimes go into Pakistan as part of his investigations. During one of these trips, Pearl went through the tragic misfortune of being kidnapped by terrorists. Al Qaeda, saw him as a media figure, and did not think twice to spare his life. Today he is remembered as a journalist, a musician, an inspiration and a dear friend.

The Daniel Pearl Foundation, formed by Daniel's friends and family, was made in honor of his achievements and his love of music. Soon after, the foundation launched Daniel Pearl World Music Days on the date that would have been Pearl's birthday. Today, the concert series has continued to grow with more than 11,000 performances in 129 countries during just the month of October. It is meant to help people grow together and understand the tragedies of war and the need for peace.

The Kadima String Quartet will play in honor of Daniel Pearl World Music Days with a performance titled Harmony for Humanity. The Kadima String Quartet is an extension of the Kadima Conservatory of Music. The Conservatory reaches out to a wide range of musicians in the Los Angeles Area. They believe that music unites people and is a basis for all human needs. Through this concert they hope to spread the same message of peace as Daniel Pearl World Music Days.
