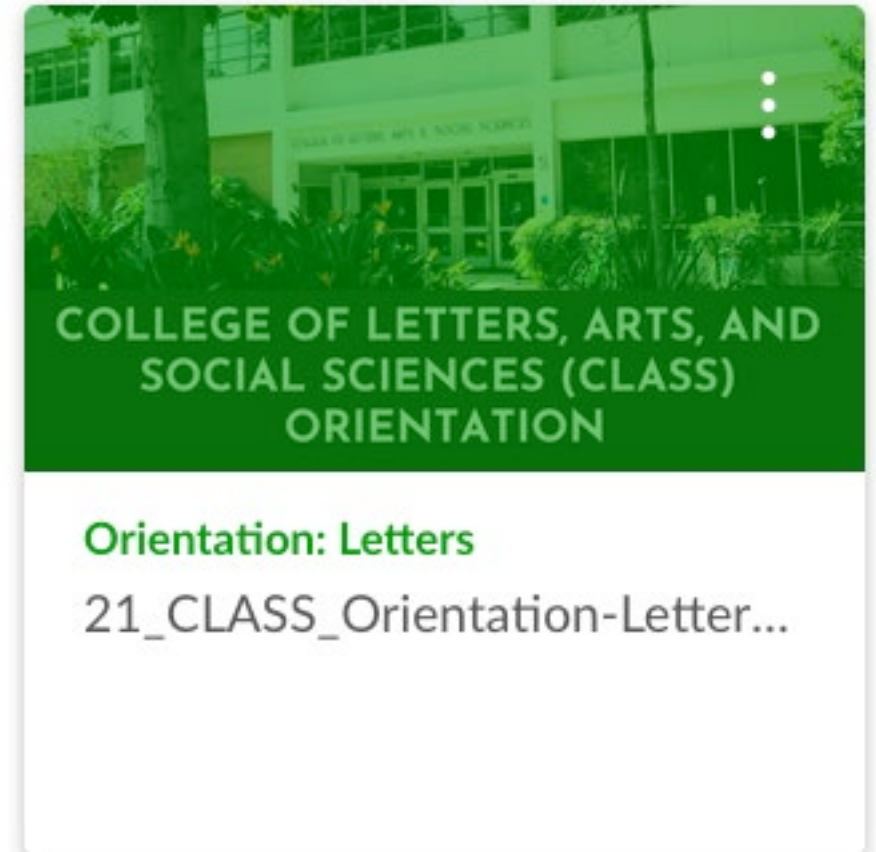

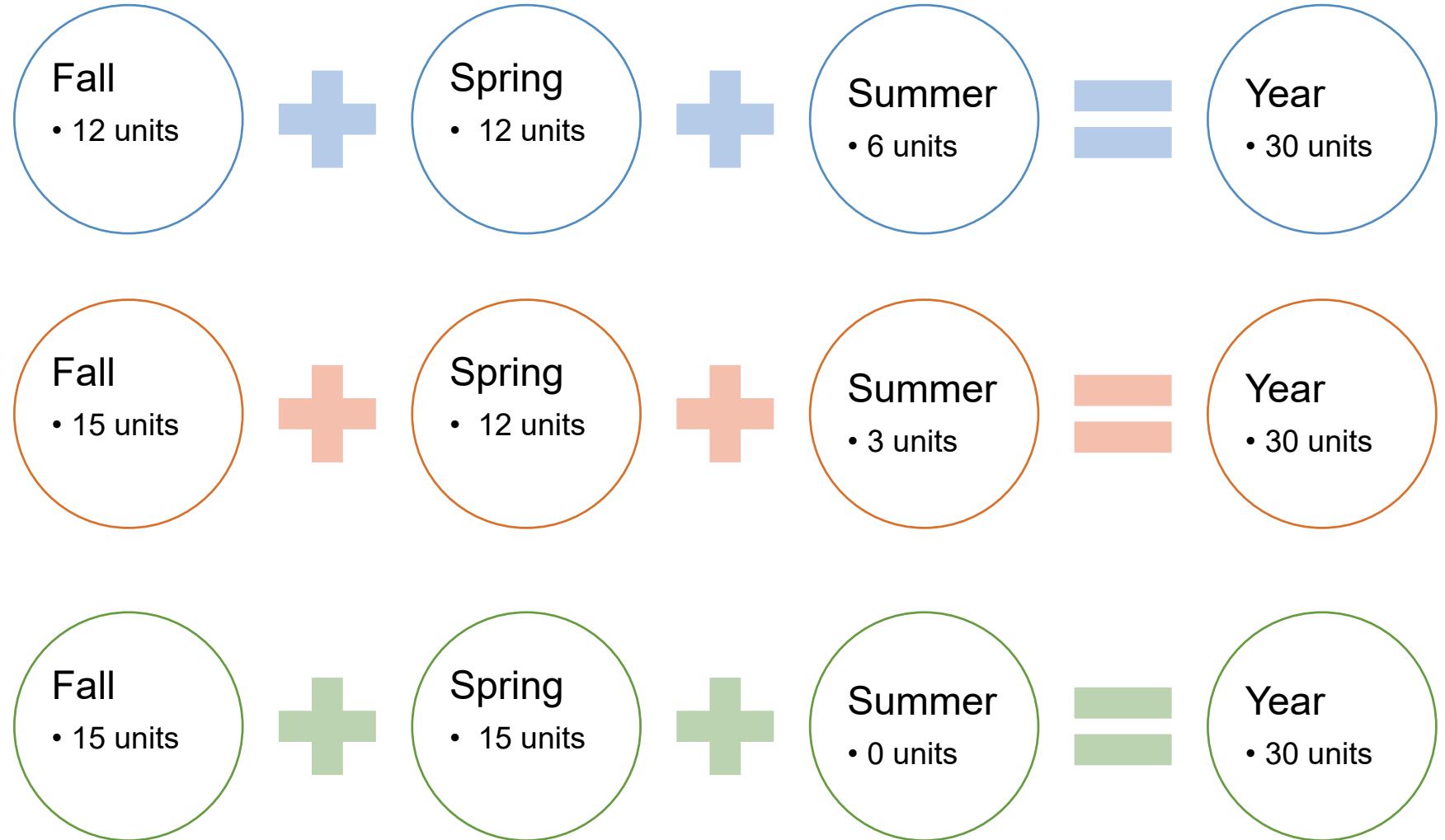
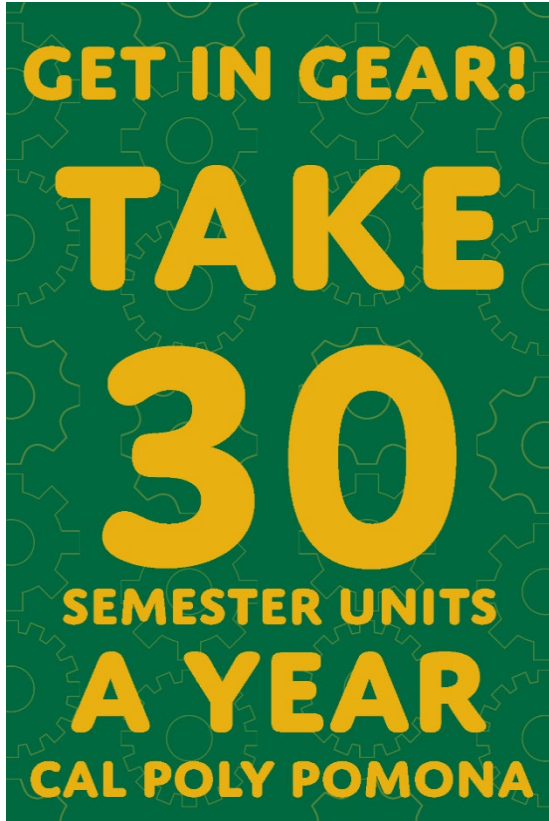

# General Education Curriculum

- GE gives you a well-rounded education.
- You need to take 48 units of General Education.
  - 39 units of lower-division courses (1000-2000 level)
  - 9 units of upper-division courses (3000-4000 level)
- **CPP changed the GE structure this year but Fall 2021 transfer students should follow the 2020-21 GE pattern.**
- **When you see Area F on your academic planning documents, ignore it. This is an incoming freshman requirement.**

• <i>Asynchronous</i>	• <i>Instructional content accessed at any time</i>
• <i>Synchronous</i>	• <i>Instruction delivered at specific times</i>
<b>Hybrid:</b>	Combination of in-person and online instruction modes
• <i>Hybrid-Asynchronous</i>	• <i>In-person meetings and anytime content online</i>
• <i>Hybrid-Synchronous</i>	• <i>In-person meetings and online meetings</i>
<b>HyFlex</b>	Students may choose to attend each class meeting in-person with the instructor, synchronously online or asynchronously online

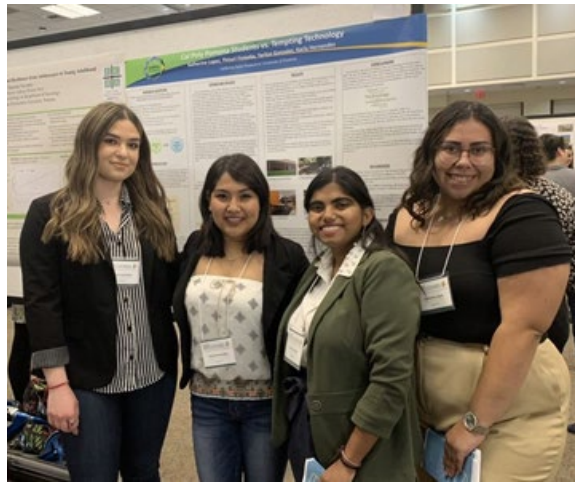
