- Double check everything discussed during advisement session.
- Ask guestions.
- Take full responsibility of making final decisions regarding your academic future.

As your advisor, you can expect me to:

- Look at you as an individual and your situation/s holistically.
- Answer your question/s regarding department and university policies and procedures.
- Collaborate with you to create an academic plan or update your academic plan.
- Make appropriate referrals to services, if you need social, personal, career, or academic support.
- Give you information on all options available to your situation.
- Provide support to help you succeed here at Cal Poly Pomona.
