First Year Student

A student must enroll in at least one class their first term at Cal Poly Pomona to maintain their active enrollment status. Freshmen students should take no more than 15 units their first semester.

Recommended courses for you to add (A2 and/or B4 Required if either Category III or IV for English and/or Math):

• GE Area A2 Course (Written Communication):

The Registrar's Office has already placed you in a GE area A2 or prerequisite to a GE area A2 course. You are more than welcome to switch to a different section or different GE area A2 course. Remember to take the Directed-Self Placement Survey (DSP) to find out which GE Area A2 course is most appropriate for you. • GE Area B4 course (Math/Qualitative Reasoning):

The Registrar's Office has already placed you in a GE area B4 or pre-requisite to a GE area B4 course. Feel free to swap to a different section or a different GE area B4 course or pre-requisite to a GE area B4 course. The Hospitality Department recommends STA 1200 or STA 1201 (pre-requisite to STA 1202). Look at the category you were placed in for math to guide you in your choice. The University should have sent you this information.

• HRT 1010 (Intro to the Hospitality Industry):

This course will be a fully synchronous course. This means that course will still meet online through zoom at the assigned time and date. Two section of HRT 1010 will be opened during orientation. Section 1 (TU/TH 8:30 A.M.-9:45 A.M.) and section 2 (TU/THU 10 A.M.-11:15 A.M.). Feel free to add either course.

• HRT 2010 (Tourism Concepts):

All three sections of this course will be opened during orientation. Section 1 and 2 are fully synchronous and section 3 is fully Asynchronous (not assigned to a date or time to meet online).

• CIS 1010 (Introduction to Personal Computing):

Only take this course if you are considering possibly adding a Business minor in the future. This class can count as an unrestricted elective and is a pre-requisite to ACC 2070. ACC 2070 can be taken to replace HRT 2740. If you are not planning to add a business minor, feel free to replace this with another general education course.

Other options if any of the above is unavailable or does not fit your schedule:

- Other GE courses (e.g. A1, A3, B1, B2, B3, C1, C2, D1, D2, GE D3, E)
- HRT elective course (e.g. HRT 2550)
- A Faculty Approved Non-HRT Major Elective Course (check "Faculty Approved non-HRT courses" list)
