


Master of Interior Architecture – Cal Poly Pomona Culminating Experience

• INA 6940 Master Project Interior Architecture Studio
Independent research and design development of an individual Master's project description and building program.

A complete design presentation is required incorporating all the skills and methods the student has developed through previous design studios.

INA 6950 Master Documents

Development of a set of construction documents with specifications and a range of drawings required to obtain complete and accurate cost estimates. Design details, methods of integrating architectural and interior design, and mechanical and electrical elements and systems are required. Demonstration of ability to be an effective entry-level member of any design firm.



Admissions Requirements to Master Program

Admissions into the Online Master of Interior Architecture degree program requires:

- Accredited 4-Year Bachelor's Degree in any field
- 3.0 Overall GPA
- Pre-requisite design coursework or equivalent to UNEX Certificate Program
- English Proficiency Requirements

 - All applicants, regardless of citizenship, who have not completed at least three
 years of full-time enrollment at the secondary level where English is the principal
 language of instruction are required to submit a TOEFL or IELTS score
 - The score to be no more than two years old.

Due to the program being fully online, Cal Poly Pomona cannot sponsor the F-1 visa for international students enrolled in the Online MIA program.



Getting Started with the Master Program

- Cal Poly Pomona does not defer admission.
- Semester system: 15 weeks of instruction and 1 week of finals.
- Students are advised to enroll in 3 courses per semester to make appropriate progress. Courses expire after 7-years. Expired courses must be repeated.

Tuition and Other Costs

Tuition

• \$715.90 per unit (the program consists of 42 units)

Tuition and fees are paid directly to Cal Poly Pomona but are only a part of a student's education costs.

Other Costs

Cost of attendance elements to take into consideration after tuition and fees:

All students are now eligible to enroll in a **Monthly Payment Plan** to cover tuition and fees. The plan will provide you with the option to start making smaller, monthly payments in advance of the semester. Enroll EARLY (even before registration) in order to lock in the longest payment term and smallest monthly payments.
