Spring 2025	16 Weeks	November 22, 2024	January 21 to May 16, 2025	\$5,900 per semester

* The U.S. Department of Homeland Security requires international students (F-1 visa holders) to enroll in at least 12 credit units each semester to maintain their legal status in the U.S. The tuition of \$5,900 covers 12 credit units (usually with four 3-unit courses).

Students will also pay: 1) Application fee of \$175; 2) International student health insurance (approximately \$650/semester); 3) Housing and food; and 4) Books, course materials, supplies, and equipment.
