CPPARC

1. **Complete MAT 1060 and PHY 1210/L by the end of Fall of your 2nd year**—this is required. Note that **MAT 1060 is a prerequisite for PHY 1210/L**, and **Area 1A is a prerequisite for ENG 2105**.
2. **Complete COM 2204 (A1) and ENG 2105 (A3)** by the end of Fall of your 2nd year if possible. While they can be taken later, they are typically required before taking upper-division GE courses (**3C, 4C, and 5D**). Lower-division courses (1000- and 2000-level) may also be taken at a community college through **Assist.org** with prior approval from an ARC staff advisor.
3. **Several GE requirements are already satisfied through the ARC curriculum: ARC 1020/1022A fulfills GE Area 3B, ARC 3610/3612 fulfills GE Area 3A, and ARC 4630 fulfills GE Area 3C.**
4. **For remaining GE areas (1A, 4A, 4B, 4C, 5B, 5D, and 6)**, you may choose any approved course in those categories. Review your DPR and consult an ARC staff advisor, especially if you are a transfer student.
5. **Additional planning notes:**
 - 1) Study Abroad opportunities are available in the 4th year;
 - 2) always enroll in studio and activity courses with the **same instructor** (e.g., ARC 1021 and ARC 1021A);
 - 3) carefully review registration notes sent before each registration period.
