With multiple medical centers, urgent care facilities, and hospitals across Los Angeles and Orange counties, you can find care close to where you live and work.



Our focus is on our members and what they need — as healthcare should be. The doctors, medical centers, and hospitals in the Vivity network work hard to ensure you receive quality healthcare that's cost-effective.

Choosing quality primary care

When people are more involved in their health, it leads to better outcomes.² With Vivity, **you have your choice** of primary care physician (PCP) to serve as your main doctor and handle things like annual exams and preventive care. The PCP will be part of a medical group or an independent practice association (IPA).

- A medical group is a team of doctors who have come together as partners. They usually share one office or building and work together to care for patients. You can often fill prescriptions and have lab tests, X-rays, and other services in the same building.
- An IPA is a group of doctors in the plan's network. They
 have their own offices and see different patients but
 have joined together to create an IPA.

Removing restrictions

Members have their choice of which medical group they want for primary care. However, members have the option to request specialty care at a partnering Vivity medical group.³

Seeing a specialist

- Through Direct Access,⁴ you can refer yourself to dermatologists; ear, nose, and throat doctors; OB-GYNs; and allergists in your medical group.
 You do not need a referral from your PCP.
- Unique to Vivity, Expanded Choice⁵ Offers more access to doctors by letting you request care from certain specialists across Vivity's network of medical groups. While typical health maintenance organizations (HMOs) only allow members to receive care from their medical group, the Expanded Choice feature gives members the choice of specialty care at partnering medical groups in the Vivity network if certain requirements are met:
- Approval for the referral is at the discretion of our medical group based on whether the care is medically necessary.
- The specific specialty requested is offered with Expanded Choice.
- The specialists at the partnering medical groups can accept Vivity members.

Offering more options

From in-person visits to virtual appointments, we have you covered.

Unique to Vivity, the away-from-home Guest
 Membership — Available to members in California
 who are temporarily residing outside Vivity's service
 area in
 Los Angeles and Orange counties. Members must
 contact the Vivity Concierge team for assistance in

applying for in-state or out-of-state Guest Memberships.

Unique to Vivity, the Nurse Patient Advocate —
 Connects you with the right healthcare resources,
 ensuring a smooth healthcare journey by organizing
 necessary referrals, resolving any issues, and
 maintaining clear communication with you. They are
 available to assist with everything from arranging
 medical appointments and coordinating services to
 supporting complex care needs such as transplant
 or bariatric care needs.

Urgent care and same-day appointments

As a Vivity HMO member, you have the benefit of having all your care coordinated by your primary care doctor. Please check with your medical group about where to go. For added convenience, you can go to any participating urgent care/immediate care site in the Vivity network, regardless of your medical group's urgent care site when you're in-area. You can view the list of participating urgent care sites on vivityhealth.com.

If you are out of the area (more than 30 miles from your primary care doctor's office), you can go to any urgent care site, including the one that is closest to you. You may log in to Anthem's Find Care provider directory tool at anthem.com/ca/find-care to search for an urgent care site near you. For follow-up care after your urgent care visit, you must see your primary care doctor or the specialist from your medical group.

Making access to care easier

A flat-fee system, called a copay, makes payments predictable. You pay a copay when you receive care, and Vivity pays the rest. There are no deductibles or hidden costs.

Telehealth services

Many network doctors offer evening and weekend office hours for convenience. You also can have virtual visits with a PCP by using each health system's telehealth option.

LiveHealth Online

With LiveHealth Online, you can have a private video visit with a doctor or licensed therapist on your smartphone, tablet, or computer with a camera — for the same copay as an office visit.⁶ You can access doctors, a therapist, or a psychiatrist through **Sydney**SM **Health** — by using a smartphone, tablet, or computer with a camera.6 Use the service for the flu, a sinus infection, a cold, a fever, or other common health issue. The doctors can assess symptoms, provide a treatment plan, and send a prescription to a pharmacy, if needed.⁷ LiveHealth Online is available for mental health concerns, too. Spanish-speaking doctors are available.

24/7 NurseLine

Registered nurses are available by phone for **support** and answers to health questions, day or night.

Finding a doctor

On the vivityhealth.com website, you can choose your primary care doctor, find a behavioral health specialist, see each health system's service areas, and access answers to common questions about each health system.



Sydney Health

The Sydney Health app connects you to your plan, your doctors, and your health data. The app includes features designed specifically for Vivity members, such as resources exclusive to your doctor and medical group practice and enhanced ways to search for care. Sydney Health also allows you to call your doctor directly through the app and search for directions to nearby urgent care centers in your health plan.

With Sydney Health, your health plan benefits, coverage details, and your digital ID card are all in one place.

Virtual visits through Sydney Health

For added convenience, you can have video visits with a doctor 24/7 through the Sydney Health app for the same copay as an office visit. Access doctors, a therapist, or

psychiatrist by using a smartphone, tablet, or computer with a camera. The doctors can assess symptoms, provide a treatment plan, and send a prescription to a pharmacy, if needed. There are also Spanish-speaking doctors available.

Wellness programs

To help encourage you to be and stay your healthiest, we offer a variety of wellness programs at no extra cost, such as:

- MyHealth Advantage: confidential, personalized health reminders and tips are sent to you.
- ConditionCare: special health support to manage diabetes, asthma, chronic obstructive pulmonary disease (COPD), or a heart condition.
- Building Healthy Families: a program available within the Sydney Health app that offers 24/7 personalized, on-demand support no matter how you choose to grow your family. Find help with family planning, pregnancy and postpartum, and raising small children.



- 3 Members can request a referral from their primary care doctor for specialty care at a partnering Vivity Medical Group. Specialty care must be deemed medically necessary, and specialists must be contracted to see Vivity patients from a partnering medical group or IPA.
- 4 Direct Access is not available in all medical groups.
- 5 Expanded Choice includes most specialty services. It excludes (i) ancillary services such as lab and radiology, and developmental and rehab therapies such as physical therapy, occupational therapy, and speech therapy; (ii) specialty services provided by a doctor of obstetrics and gynecology; and (iii) specialty services provided by a pediatrician.
- 6 Appointments subject to availability of a therapist. Online counseling is not appropriate for all kinds of problems. If you receive care from a doctor or healthcare provider not in your plan's network, your share of the costs may be higher. You may also receive a bill for any charges not covered by your health plan.

Sydney Health is offered through an arrangement with Carelon Digital Platforms, a separate company offering mobile application services on behalf of your health plan. LiveHealth Online is offered through an arrangement with Amwell, a separate company, providing telehealth services on behalf of your health plan.
