# TASK-CHARGE



#### Proposed planning/design process:

- ✓ Meet with staff and stakeholders -- start w/ASI Facilities + Operations Committee (suggest a 'working group' to manage the process
- ✓ **Investigate options + constraints -** especially for shade structures (existing subsurface structures or utilities, etc.)
- ✓ Facilitate an open workshop to gain additional input from students, staff, faculty
  - challenges/opportunities (BSC in general)
  - priorities exercise for plaza project
  - survey visual preferences for furnishings and shade structures
- Document workshop input and share with stakeholders

(ASI F+0 Committee, Foundation, CPP Planning + Facilities, MP Advisory Committee, format to post on MP and ASI websites)

- Develop design concepts (with alternatives as appropriate, review with the working group to identify preferred concept)
- Present the proposed concept (with a cost estimate + documentation of the process and student input)



#### **Proposed BSC Study process:**

- ✓ **Data gathering** about the use of the BSC, including changes in use over time, and analysis of actual utilization (vs perceptions)
- Investigation of the existing BSC building and systems to inform assumptions about expansion options and planning studies
- Sketch studies for BSC expansion including how the BSC relates to University Park, bookstore, etc.
- Sketch studies for proposed parking structure behind the BSC (west side) and conference center space on the upper level, including feasibility of connecting the new space to the BSC upper level
- Study potential to improve the south end of the BSC, facing the multi-use mall (Eucalyptus Lane) by shifting access to some service and dock functions currently on the south end of the building
- Facilitate input from stakeholders with focus sessions and work shops, starting with the plaza shade/seating workshop and continuing to work with the ASI F+O Committee, MP Executive and Advisory Committees.
- Present the preferred approach to BSC improvement and expansion, along with study findings, the planning process and a range of likely cost, for leadership consideration and inclusion in the master plan.

#### Campus-wide:

Students express an appreciation of the campus spaces, but the lack of shade limits their ability to use those spaces.

Lack of shade also constrains turnout at student events, impacting student engagement.


#### Students were asked questions related to the campus:



## ON A TYPICAL DAY, TIME (IN HOURS) SPENT AT BSC?


While about 1 in five spends less than 2 hrs/day at the BSC, half said they spend half their day (4 hrs or more) there.



## **FAVORITE PLACE TO STUDY IN THE BSC?**




Top choice is the Upper +

#### **FAVORITE PLACE TO SOCIALIZE IN THE BSC?**









#### **SOME ADDITIONAL CONCERNS WERE:**

- More seating and shade by CLA shuttle stop.
- Shade needed for bike paths and pedestrians.
- More accessible stairs on west side of campus near College of Environmental Design.
- More seating and shade at bus stop near Temple Ave Parking structure and Cal Poly Pomona Parking Structure 2.
- More seating and shade near stop for Village Shuttle.
- Re-plant trees in areas around the Engineering building, the Library, and the Conference Center.



- groups or individuals












## **CONCEPTS:** Seating-Shade Pilot Project











- Add more of the same table currently on the back side of the BSC
- Locate around the grass circle (near existing tables, but in sunny area)
- Expensive per seat, not a creative leap, table tops had issues
- Still needs a power source nearby





- Go Table, standing/stool height
- Movable stools
- Solar panel, battery storage (can also have hard-wired power)
- Mix with non-canopy tables?
