As a Residential Suite resident, you and your suitemates are responsible for maintaining the cleanliness of your kitchen, bathroom, living room, and individual bedrooms. Below is a list of items to consider bringing—or coordinating with your suitemates to bring.



Bathroom Items

- ☐ Toilet paper
- ☐ Shower curtain*
- ☐ Shower curtain rings*
- ☐ Bath mat(s)
- ☐ Towels
- ☐ Plunger
- ☐ Trash bin (optional)

Cleaning Supplies

- ☐ Shower/tub cleaner
- ☐ Toilet cleaner and brush
- ☐ Glass cleaner and cleaning cloths/paper towels
- ☐ Broom and dustpan
- ☐ Floor mop and cleaning product (Swiffer-type mop)
- ☐ Disinfectant spray or wipes
- ☐ Garbage bags



It is every Suite Residents responsibility to clean their suite i.e. bathroom, kitchen, living room, and bedroom.



Kitchen Supplies

- ☐ Glass stove top cookware
- ☐ Dish soap
- ☐ Dish towels
- ☐ Baking soda (for odors)
- ☐ Eating utensils
- ☐ Plates/bowls
- ☐ Cups
- ☐ Paper towels/napkins
- ☐ Additional trash cans, especially larger trash can for kitchen use
- ☐ Food prep items for cooking/baking
- ☐ Filtered water pitcher (optional)
- ☐ Dish rack/drying mat (optional)
- ☐ Tupperware (optional)
- ☐ Storage bins/drawers (optional)
