Checklist for cleaning your space

Residence Life Team will use a similar list to ensure your space has been vacated properly.

All personal belongings, trash, food, etc. must be removed during move-out or you will be charged an improper move-out fee.

Front Door

- Items removed (No decorations, hooks, stickers or residue)
- No holes

Wardrobes & Dresser

- Items removed
- Cleaned and dusted
- No missing rods
- Door intact

Bed & Mattress

- Returned to original configuration (Residents must adjust bed height back to original height at move-in)
- Cleaned
- Frame/structure not damaged
- No rips or holes

Mini Fridge (if applicable)

- Refrigerator removed from room
- Tray or mat removed from under refrigerator
- No water damage

Shelves

- Empty
- Cleaned and dusted
- No damage

Desk & Chair (do not use chairs to move out belongings)

- Items removed
- No breaks or cracks
- No broken chairs

Carpet/Flooring

- Flooring swept
- No stains, rips or burns

Walls & Ceiling

- (Be careful not to remove wall paint)
- All items removed (No decorations remaining)
- No holes or marks
- Remove adhesive strips (LED lights, command strips, etc.)
- Paint is in good condition
- Smoke detector present
- Sprinkler not damaged

Lights

- All are working

Windows

- Windows locked
- Stickers /signs removed
- Blinds not missing or broken
- No cracked glass

Trash/Recycling (2)

- Empty
- Cleaned (inside and outside)

Bathroom

- Personal locks removed from lockers
- Personal items removed from lockers

Report any damage you or your roommate are responsible for through email to your Area Coordinator (AC) prior to move-out.
