### **Basic Room Controls**

The AV equipment in 5-133 is designed as a **Basic Classroom** with the devices controlled via separate remotes. The computer in the room required a Bronco Username and Password to operate.

For switching inputs an Extron SW4 can be found on the Instructor Station with the corresponding device inputs labelled.



#### Input Selections


INPUT 1	Instructor Station PC

# Projecting and Volume Adjustments

The main function of the projector remote is for power, and volume settings. A few other functions like E-Zoom and AV-mute are useful for most classroom situations without hindering instruction.

You will also want to make sure that the projector is first set to HDMI 1 using button 8 (HDMI/Video) to switch to the correct source.

- 1. Power button
- 2. E-Zoom +/- buttons (zoom into and out of the image)
- 3. A/V Mute button (turns off picture and sound)
- 4. Freeze button (stops video action)
- 5. Volume up/down buttons (adjust speaker volume)
- 6. Pointer button (activates on-screen pointer)
- 7. Esc button (cancels/exits functions and controls wireless mouse functions)
- 8. HDMI/Video (switches through HDMI sources)

### Stream from a Mac to Apple TV

- Mirror a Mac screen on Apple TV: On the Mac, do either of the following:
  - Mac with macOS Big Sur or later: Click Control Center 🔓 in the menu bar, click Screen Mirroring 

    , then choose the name of the Apple TV you want to use.
    - To end screen mirroring, click Control Center  $\cong$  in the menu bar, click Screen Mirroring  $\stackrel{\frown}{}$ , then click the name of the Apple TV.
  - Mac with macOS Catalina or earlier: Click in the menu bar, then choose the name of the Apple TV you want to use.

To end screen mirroring, click in the menu bar, then choose Turn AirPlay Off.

 Stream audio from a Mac to Apple TV: Click the Sound icon in the Mac menu bar, then choose the name of the Apple TV.

### Stream from an iOS or iPadOS device to Apple TV

Do one of the following:

- Mirror the screen of an iOS or iPadOS device on Apple TV: On the iOS or iPadOS device, swipe to open Control Center, tap Screen Mirroring , then select Apple TV in the list of AirPlay devices.
  - To end mirroring, make sure Control Center is open on your device, tap —, then tap Stop Mirroring.
- Stream video from an iOS or iPadOS device to Apple TV: Start playing video on the iOS or iPadOS device, tap in the video window, then select Apple TV in the list of AirPlay devices.

To stop streaming, tap  $\square$  at the top of the screen, then select Play on [iOS or iPadOS device].

*Note:* If you have an Apple TV 4K and an iOS or iPadOS device that supports 4K HDR video, your videos from the Photos app will stream in full 4K HDR resolution.
