


GETTING STARTED

121-1967 contains standard presentation functions controlled through the touch panel in the lectern and seats 48 occupants. Lighting controls can be found on the right side of the door as you enter the room. Please contact x2290 for any questions about the room, or x4040 for any technical issues.







STARTUP

To start up the projector and screen, follow the on-screen instructions on the touch panel. Give the projector some time to warm up, then select your input method to begin setting up a presentation.

The system in 1967 is designed to also work in a combined mode with 1969 and will ask if the room is being used in a "Divided" or a "Combined" mode. Select "Divided" to use the room standalone then follow the on-screen prompts.






INPUTS

Laptop	Sourced from a laptop plugged into either the loose HDMI or VGA cable within the lectern where the touch panel is located.
PC	This input uses the lecterns built-in computer and will require a Bronco username and password to access.
Wireless Presentation	This input will only work for a device that is connected to the campus eduroam Wi-Fi network using the Mersive Solstice app.





COMBINED MODE

When first starting the system, you will be asked to select from the following options which will dictate the configuration of the technology within the room when being used in a combined setting.

Lectern Location		
West	The most common location for the lectern. This would be at the head of 1967 by the White Wall	
Center	Center of both 1967 and 1969 along the Blue Wall.	
Projector Selection		
White Wall	Brings down the primary projector screen at the head end of 1967.	
Blue Wall	Brings down the secondary projector in 1967 as well as the primary one in 1969.

The conference phone located to the right of the whiteboard and can only be used for dialing on campus extensions. When dialing, only the extension is needed to commit the call.
