


## Selecting the Featurette Content Layout

Select the Featurette radio button to start this content layout.





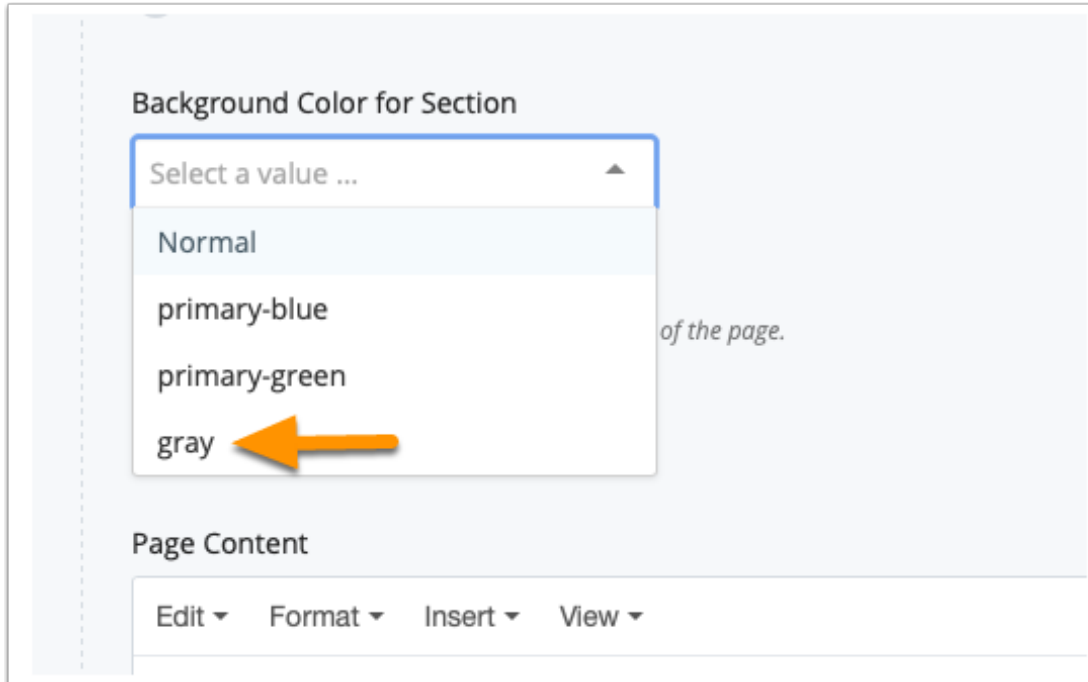

You are also able to choose from a list of background colors to add color to your site. This is an optional setting but featurettes work really well with a color. We will select gray for this one.



## Choosing and image

Remember to upload the image prior to selecting it. Refer to the tutorial on uploading images.

Featurettes have a larger image either on the left or right so be sure to choose your preferred location. If you are putting multiple featurettes on a page it looks good to have the images switch between left and right. Add the alternative text description if this image is important to the content. 

## Add Text

Featurettes work well with less text. It is more of a marketing layout to call attention to something you want to feature.
