


MSTI Scholar Award Opportunity

Because of the high demand for fully qualified math and science teachers, CEMaST offers financial support to Cal Poly students who are pursuing their single subject teaching credentials in math or science. Each candidate is eligible for up to four \$2,500 scholarships (one per semester), totaling \$10,000.



MSTI Scholar Award Requirements

- Open to CPP seniors and credential students.
- Must be a math or science major.
- Have an overall undergraduate GPA of 3.0. Credential students must have a GPA of 3.4 in their credential coursework.
- Must submit 2 letters of recommendation.
- Credential students must have subject matter competency through coursework or passing appropriate CSET tests.



MSTI Obligations



MSTI Scholars are required to:

- Obtain their teaching credential at Cal Poly Pomona.
- Attend six MSTI Seminars per year.
- Meet with a single subject advisor.
- Teach in a high need public school district within California for every year of MSTI Scholarship support.
