There are three ways to access your Title IX training, which will be detailed in the following pages.

1. Via MyCPP Portal
2. Via CPP Outlook Email
3. Via typing in the link

Title IX training is due **August 9**. Holds will be placed on student accounts if not completed by the due date.

The checklist and hold code will be removed within 3 – 4 hours of training completion. We kindly ask that students allow the automated process to release the holds and only contact OEC once sufficient time has passed.

1. Accessing Title IX training via MyCPP Portal.

- Go on a browser and search up “MyCPP Portal”
- Sign in with your CPP credentials.
- Upon login, look for “My Holds & To-Dos”.
- This should automatically be at the center of your screen. It will inform you of any mandatory trainings and a link to access them.

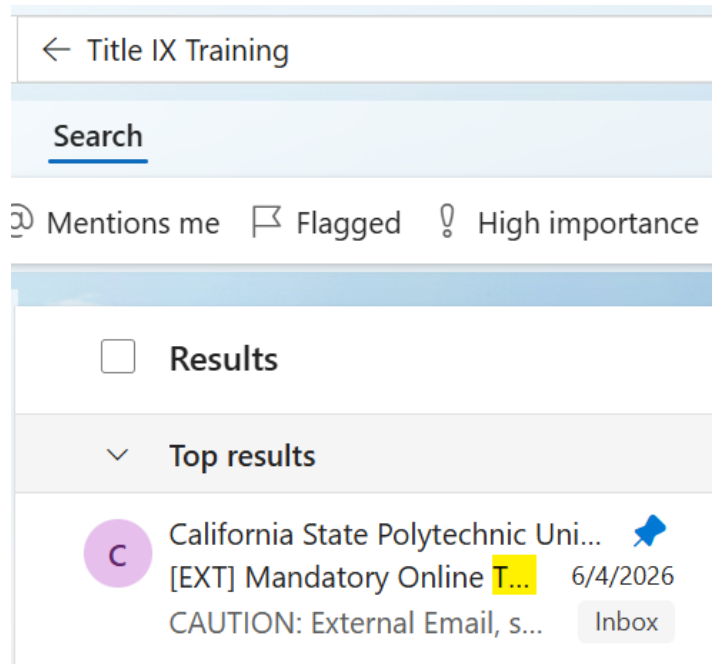
