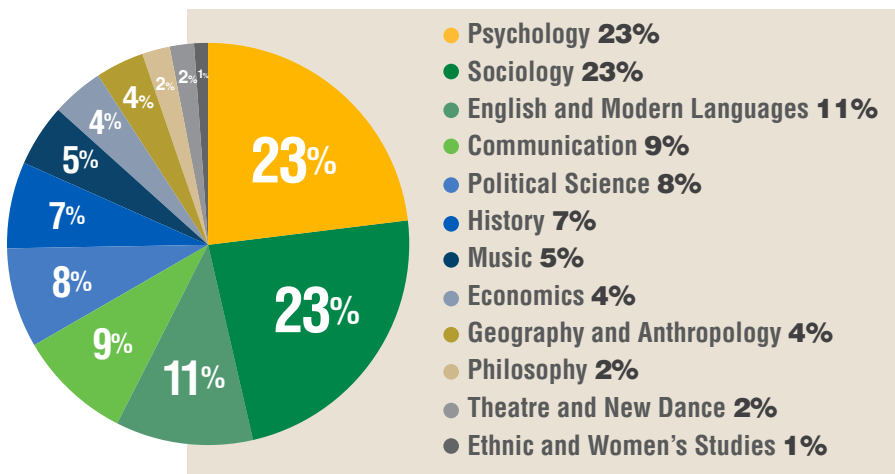


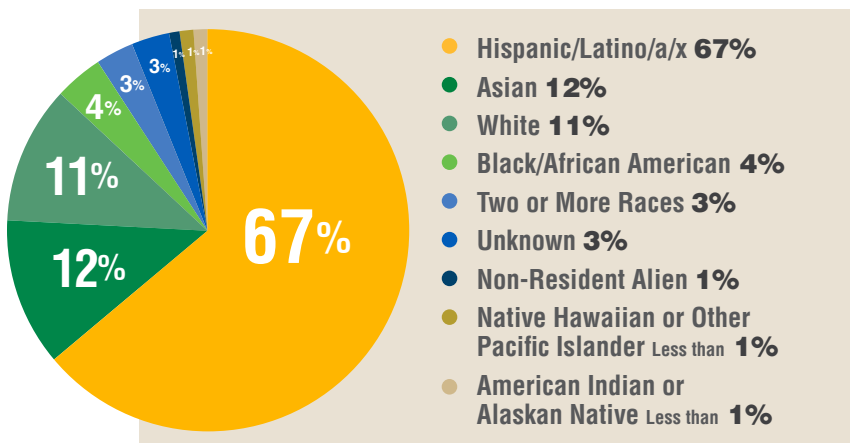

POINTS OF PRIDE

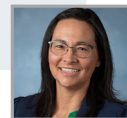
Students participating in the **NATIONAL MODEL UNITED NATIONS** have won awards every year since 2000. The 2021-23 team earned "Outstanding Delegation."
