



Annual Report on Regulated Equipment and Tools

In July 2022, pursuant to Assembly Bill 481 (AB 481), the California State University Board of Trustees approved a system-wide Regulated Equipment and Tools Policy for its university police departments. This policy was adopted and published by the California State Polytechnic University, Pomona Police Department (CPP PD) within Policy 706.

AB 481 and Policy 706 require that we publish certain information annually regarding specified regulated equipment and tools. Of the regulated types of equipment and tools outlined in AB 481, CPP PD maintains the Matrice 210 and Mavic 2 Pro unmanned aerial systems (UASs), Defense Technology 40mm sponge-tip launchers, and Remington 870 12-gauge less-lethal shotguns.

To enhance transparency and communication, CPP PD will host a community engagement event on October 24, 2025, at 3pm in the CPP PD conference room (room 224) located at 3801 West Temple Avenue, Building 109, Pomona, CA 91768.

Information regarding the use, policy compliance, funding, and inventory for the period of July 1, 2024, through June 30, 2025, is outlined below.

Summary of use and purpose:

CPP PD used the Matrice 210 UAS during two separate events between July 1, 2024, and June 30, 2025. In both instances, the purpose was to provide aerial situational awareness of ingress and egress during populated events.

Summary of any complaints or concerns received concerning regulated equipment and tools:

CPP PD did not receive any complaints or concerns regarding the use of the equipment and tools outlined in AB 481.

Results of any internal audits, any information about violations of the regulated equipment and tools policy, and any actions taken in response:

CPP PD did not receive any audit findings or information about violations associated with the regulated equipment and tools policy.



Annual cost and source of funds for regulated tools and equipment:

Total expenditures in fiscal year 2024/25 for purchases of regulated equipment and tools outlined in AB 481 was approximately \$10,000.00 which was expended from the sale of obsolete equipment and the CPP PD general fund budget.

Current inventory of regulated equipment and tools:

CPP PD currently possesses (1) Matrice 210 UAS, (1) Mavic 2 Pro UAS, (3) Defense Technology 40mm sponge-tip launchers, and (2) Remington 870 12-gauge less-lethal shotguns.

Planned purchases of regulated equipment and tools in fiscal year 2025/26:

CPP PD plans to purchase a UAS following the sale of the decommissioned Matrice 210 and Mavic 2 Pro UASs.
