Now that you are enrolled in a CSU Fully Online course at **Cal Poly Pomona**, we would like to give you some information and resources to help you successfully complete your online course.

**You are a student at Cal Poly Pomona (CPP)** and with your CPP “Bronco” Student ID number, you can explore and have access to a wealth of online resources.

Your Student Portal and gateway to campus online services is **MyCPP**, you will find it by clicking the link [MyCPP](#). You must have your Bronco Number, before you can access **MyCPP**. This information will be sent to you in a separate communication. **The academic calendar at Cal Poly Pomona** may be different than your home campus. Here are some key dates to remember for **Fall 2021**:

FALL 2021 IMPORTANT TIMELINES	DATES
First day of classes	August 19 <sup>th</sup>
Last day to drop classes without course being recorded	September 1 <sup>st</sup>
Class Withdrawal: Students may continue to withdraw from classes via Self Service in BroncoDirect. Students will receive “W” grades but may petition for “WX” grade.	September 2 <sup>nd</sup> – 16 <sup>th</sup>
Last day of classes	December 5, 2021
Finals Week	December 6 <sup>th</sup> – 12 <sup>th</sup>
Last Day to Withdraw by Petition for Serious and Compelling Reasons and Receive a “W” grade.	November 12 <sup>th</sup>
Grades due	December 15 <sup>th</sup>
Days campus is closed for holidays	September 6 <sup>th</sup> ; November 11 <sup>th</sup> ; and November 25 & 26 <sup>th</sup>



Should you wish to drop your Fully Online course, once you have been successfully enrolled, please click [CSU Fully Online](#) for instructions and frequently asked questions.

After completion of the course, the grade will be automatically transferred to your home CSU campus and posted as transfer credit. As a student at CPP, you will need transcripts from us for any future academic endeavors (transfer or graduate school). In addition, your academic standing at CPP, where your online class originates, will count, so if you receive a D, F, or WU in this class, you may be put on academic probation or become disqualified even if you remain in good standing at your home campus. This status will become part of your permanent academic record.

The **online course delivery** at Cal Poly Pomona may be different compared to your home campus.

1. Our courses are supported by a NEW technology platform called **CANVAS**. More information will be available to you nearing the Fall 2021 semester.
2. You have access to all our University Library resources, and you can explore our online library services at [University Library](#).
