Required Training for Employees & Volunteers

The following training courses are a requirement for all CPP volunteers who work with minors, employees working with minors in a one-time event, and employees working with minors in day/overnight camps. This includes faculty, staff, student assistants, and auxiliaries.

The following training courses are a requirement for all CPP Youth Program Sponsors and Directors/Administrators that run day/overnight camps, summer camps, youth programs, etc. (MPPs, Auxiliaries/Managers/Supervisors/Deans).
