

Supplemental Information on filing a Request by an Undergraduate for Graduate/Undergraduate Credit

Undergraduate students who have senior standing may request to have their courses counted towards graduate credit/undergraduate credit. Students must file a petition to receive graduate credit in 300, 400, and 500 level courses and undergraduate credit in 500 level courses. An undergraduate student may not register in any 600-level course. The petition is due in the Graduate Studies Office by the last week of the quarter in which the course is taken. An undergraduate may petition for up to 13-quarter units of graduate and undergraduate courses to be taken for graduate credit and up to 13-quarter units of graduate courses to be taken for undergraduate credit.
