- WHEREAS, Faithfully served students in the MS Degree Program in Kinesiology and Foods and Nutrition by chairing or serving on their thesis committee; and
- WHEREAS Developed the Kinesiology and Health Promotion Psychophysiology Lab for graduate student research; and
- WHEREAS, Published in high quality journals with graduate students and colleagues in the field of exercise, nutrition, or stress management usually as the statistical consultant; and
- WHEREAS Taught a wide array of Kinesiology undergraduate courses demonstrating a breadth of expertise in health and psychology resulting in excellent faculty peer and student evaluations; and
- WHEREAS, Distinguished himself as a superb educator, a brilliant instructor with teachers and students, a community advocate, and a team player in all department and college matters, including co-chairing the CLASS Teaching and Learning Committee; and
- WHEREAS, Represented Cal Poly Pomona in all areas with professionalism, integrity, and care; therefore be it
- RESOLVED, That the Academic Senate of California State Polytechnic University, Pomona unanimously express its deepest appreciation for his many years of dedicated service to the students and faculty of the University; and be it further
- RESOLVED, That this resolution and the title of "Professor Emeritus" be posthumously awarded in honor of the legacy of mentorship left by Professor Thomas Spalding in recognition of his many accomplishments and contributions, and that it be permanently recorded in the Minutes and Archives of the Academic Senate.
