BACKGROUND: The Department of Art has put forward a referral for a Studio Arts Minor for semesters. This is a new program.

The Studio Arts Minor is a collection of foundation studio art courses, art history courses, and upper division studio arts electives, designed to give students from any major or discipline, a comprehensive overview of the discipline, processes, materials, and concepts employed in the Studio Arts. The courses offered as part of the Studio Arts Minor are housed in the Visual Communication Design Major Core and Approved Electives.

In addition to the broader campus community, the minor would be open to both Art History majors and Visual Communication Design majors.
