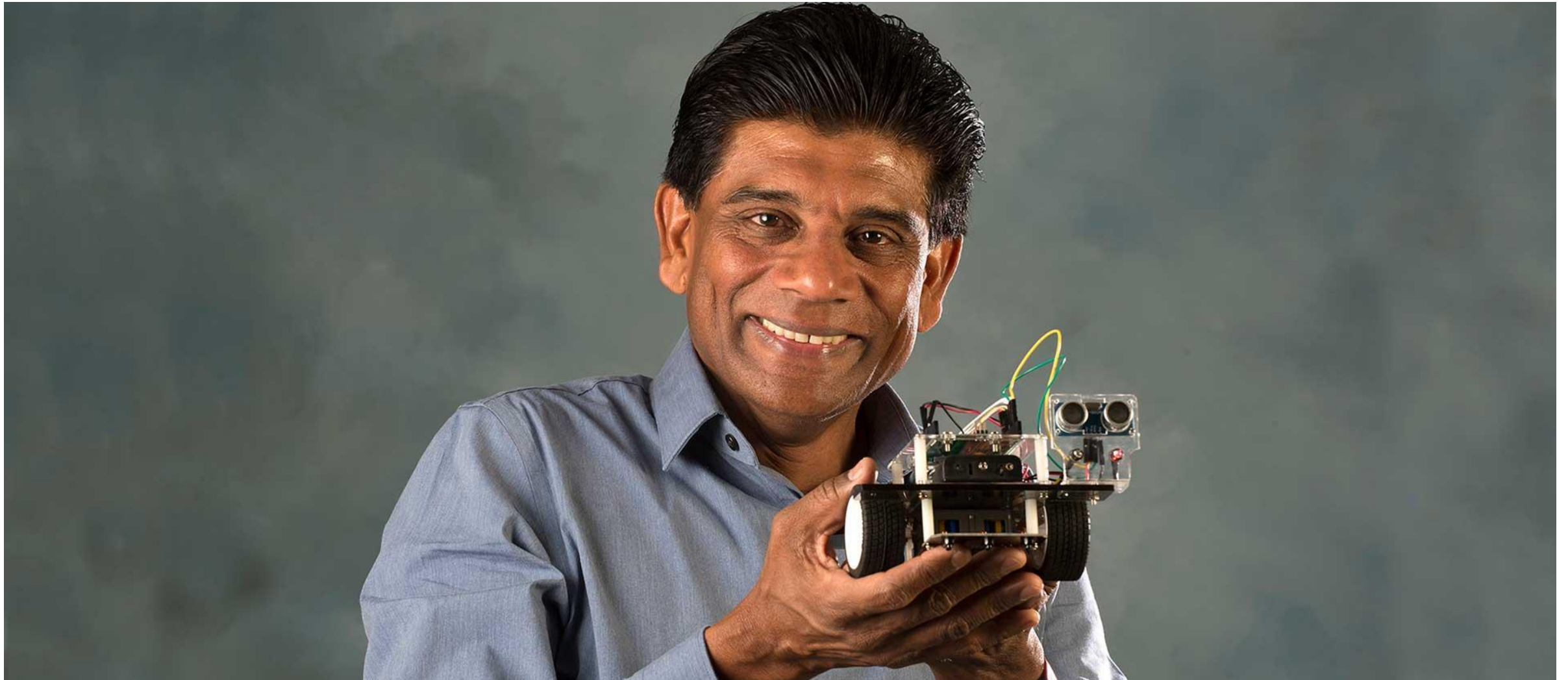

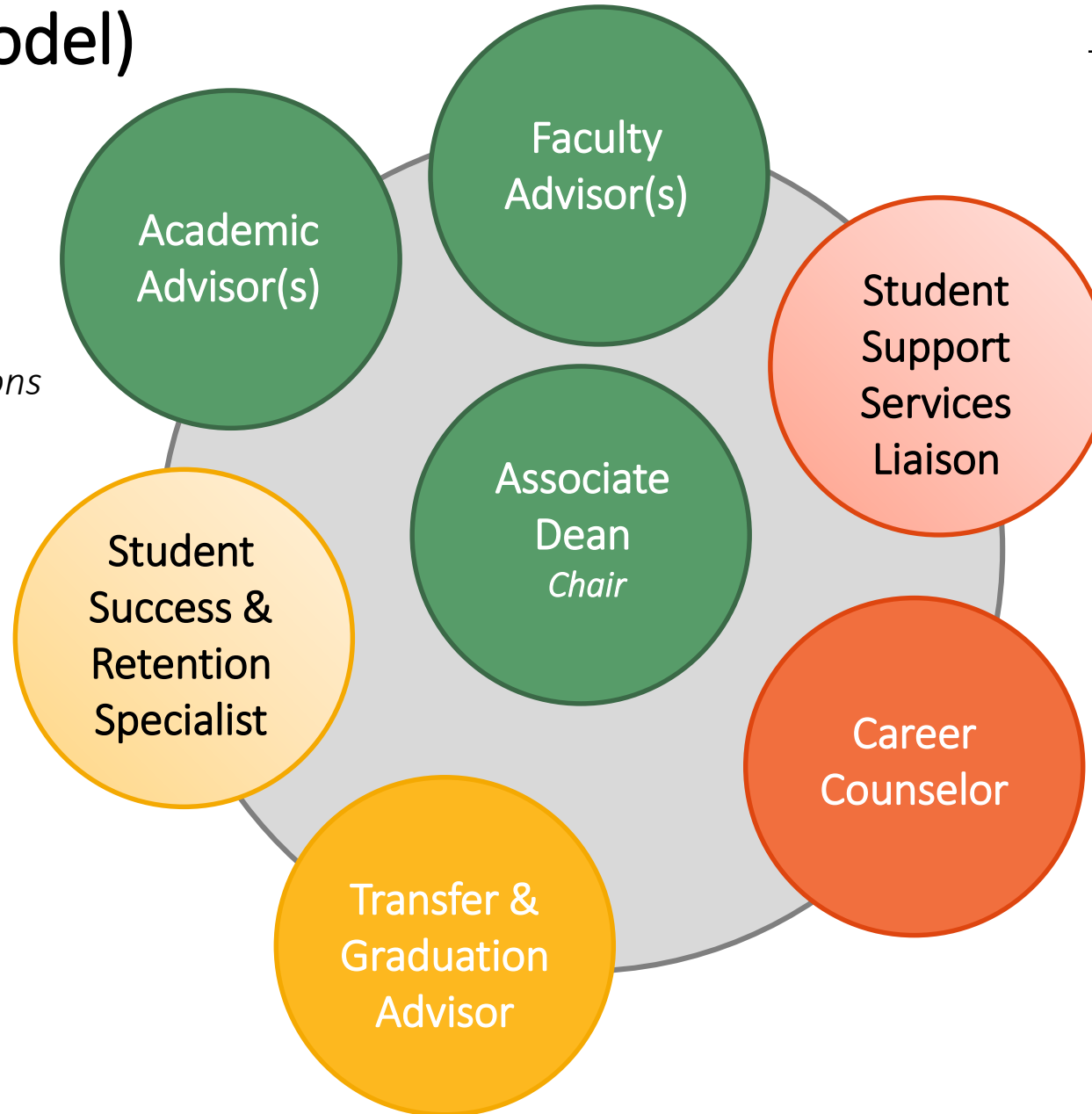

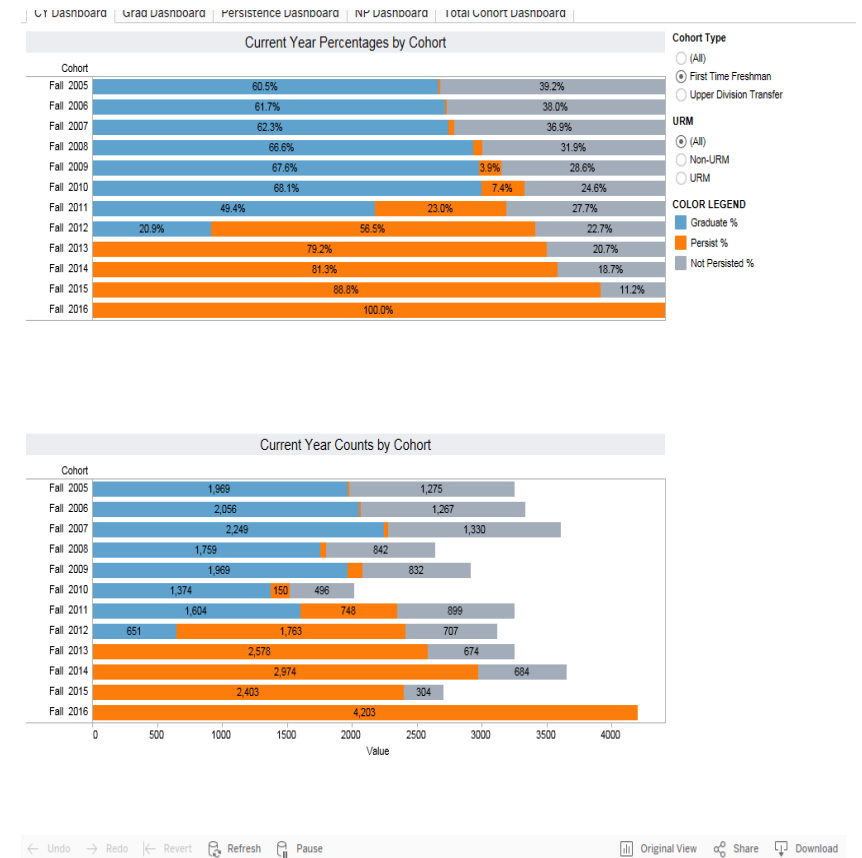
- Current year percentage by cohort
