<u>BACKGROUND</u>: The Department of Animal and Veterinary Science has put forward an option in Animal Science under the existing B.S. in Animal Science program for semesters. This is a new option.

This program is intended for two groups of students. If a student is interested in being employed in a career that involves working with animals, but does not want to go to graduate school or veterinary school, this option would be appropriate. This option prepares students to begin such a career after they earn their B.S. degree. Another group of students may start their bachelor's program, intending to continue their education in graduate or veterinary school. If, for some reason (e.g., their academic performance), they later decide not to pursue graduate or veterinary school, they can transfer from a pre-vet option seamlessly into this option. With the exception of one course (i.e., physics), the first two years of the Pre-Vet option and this option are the same.
