1. Governor’s 2018-2019 Spending Plan

Summary of Budget in Regard to the CSU: An additional \$92.1 million base growth from last year, with the expectation that these funds will be used to make progress on the Graduation Initiative.

Status Details

- CSU (Chancellor and BOT) asked \$263 million more than last year to admit another 3,641 FTE students (one percent enrollment growth) next fall.
- CSU expects to raise revenue with a tuition increase that BOT would approve in March, 2018.
- CFA calls on the Chancellor, Trustees, Governor, and Legislature to support increased funding for the CSU that includes funding for at least a five (5) percent increase in student enrollment in 2018-19, which would open up spaces for more than 18,000 additional students to attend the CSU. That requires \$422 million more than last year.
