**BACKGROUND:** The Department of Education in the College of Education and Integrative Studies has put forward a referral for a revised semester version of the Intern Credential Program. This program includes Multiple Subject, Single Subject, and Education Specialist programs, offering a separate pathway toward the teaching credential. Students in the intern program work fulltime in schools while they are working toward their credential. Students in the intern programs follow the same progression of coursework as students in the general programs.

Before reaching the Academic Programs Committee, this program was reviewed by the Department of Education Curriculum Committee in the College of Education and Integrative Studies, as well as the Dean of the College of Education and Integrative Studies and the Office of Academic Programs. Students in the Multiple-Subject Intern program follow the same progression of coursework as students in the general Multiple-Subject Credential program. Students in the Single-Subject Intern program follow the same progression of coursework as students in the general Single-Subject Credential program. And students in the Education Specialist Intern program follow the same progression of coursework as students in the general Education Specialist Credential program.
