BACKGROUND: The Department of Education in the College of Education and Integrative Studies has put forward a referral for a revised semester version of the Intern Credential Program. This program includes Multiple Subject, Single Subject, and Education Specialist programs, offering a separate pathway toward the teaching credential. Students in the intern program work fulltime in schools while they are working toward their credential. Students in the intern programs follow the same progression of coursework as students in the general programs.

Program Description	The Intern Program includes Multiple Subject, Single Subject, and Education Specialist programs, offering a separate pathway toward a credential. That is, students in the Intern Program work fulltime in the schools while they are working on their credential. Students in the Multiple-Subject Intern program follow the same progression of coursework as students in the general Multiple-Subject Credential program. Students in the Single-Subject Intern program follow the same progression of coursework as students in the general Single-Subject Credential program. And students in the Education Specialist Intern program follow the same progression of coursework as students in the general Education Specialist Credential program.
