BACKGROUND: This is a revised semester program put forward by the College of Education. The program has been revised to emphasize current research and policies of systemic reform and contextualized leadership integrating theories on organizations, policy, cognition, and social change. Specific course titles and descriptions have been updated to align with the requirements of the CA enabling legislation and CSU Executive Order 991, within the structure of the original EDD program proposal. The updates also reemphasize the program commitment to educational quality, equity, and justice for all students.
