- Advising Strategies:
 - Focus is on the students who have the potential to graduate by summer 2018
 - (0-60 units from degree as of April 2017).
 - The list is available on the MyPlanner/IAP Tableau dashboard.
 - Students should complete their Individual Academic Plan (IAP), if they have not done so.
 - Encourage students to use MyPlanner to map out their remaining quarter courses.
 - Chairs and college leadership should anticipate and make decisions impacting students' ability to graduate (i.e., course substitutions, sequences, exceptions, etc.).
 - Conversion guides will be released by the end of the term.
 - Access the Conversion guides on the semester conversion website.

- Communication Strategies:
 - A **Q2S Student Handbook** will be published and posted to the Semester Conversion website next week.
 - The handbook provides comprehensive information on what to expect and how to prepare for conversion.
 - The Semester Conversion website will be re-launched next week.
 - There will be heavy digital presence on social media channels once the conversion guide is posted and the new website is launched.
