

State Budget Outlook & Priorities

- Continued Revenue Growth averaging 3% through 2022-23
- Governor's Priorities
 - Build reserves, eliminate debts & reduce liabilities
 - Assist the most vulnerable Californians
 - Invest in existing state programs
- Cautiously Optimistic

	Governor's Budget
Compensation & Mandatory Costs	\$193 Million
2% Enrollment Growth (7,295 FTES)	\$62 Million
Graduation Initiative 2025	\$45 Million
Project Rebound	\$250,000
Total	\$300 Million



2019-20 One-Time Funding

	Governor's Budget
Deferred Maintenance	\$247 million
Basic Needs Partnerships	\$15 million
Total	\$262 million
