Rapid Response to the COVID-19 Pandemic

- Transition to virtual instruction and remote work
- Temporary Credit / No Credit grade option for students
- Temporary policy adjustments to minimize negative impact on:
 - Undergraduate students
 - Graduate students
 - Permanent faculty
 - Lecturers
- Modifications to admissions practices.

Additional Guidance for Spring 2020

- Remote and virtual instruction continues.
- Final exams and culminating projects must be remote.
- Synchronous instruction must stay on the originally-scheduled meeting days/times and final exam schedule.
- If possible, move to asynchronous instruction.

Summer 2020 and beyond

- Remote work and online/virtual instruction continues.
- Anticipate that the first part of Fall 2020 may require virtual instruction.
- New student orientation, summer advising, and student engagement will be virtual.
- New faculty orientation will be virtual.
- Expand faculty development strategies to prepare for 2.0

2019-20 Faculty Searches

- Continued commitment to diversify and increase tenure-track faculty.
- The state budget context.
- Status and update of faculty searches:
 - Started the academic year with 53 faculty searches.
 - 40 faculty searches have been completed.
 - 13 faculty searches will be rolled forward.

Early Alerts and Progress Reports

- 50,564 course reports submitted.
- Nearly 40% of all instructors submitted reports for their course(s).
- 4,588 students were identified “at-risk.”
- High-touch interventions by Academic Affairs & Student Affairs professionals.
 - Targeted tutoring, emergency grant, housing, technology needs, mental health counseling, advisor support on withdrawal process, taking course for credit/no credit
