TITLE OF REFERRAL: GE-012-201: CS 3750: Computers and Society (B5/D4, modification)

BACKGROUND:

This is a request to modify course description with the addition in course description to read: "Overview of computer and information technology (e.g., networking and communications, information management). Secure computing principles and practice." They updated the instruction mode and prerequisites to "Lower division GE requirements in Area A, at least two sub-areas in Area B, and at least two sub-areas in Area D," to conform with the language of B5 and D4 Upper Division Synthesis courses.

DISCUSSION:
