TITLE OF REFERRAL: GE-016-201: EWS 2011: African American Historical Experience (Modification)

BACKGROUND:

This is a modification of an existing Area D3 course to an Area F course. This was done to comply with the CSU and CPP requirement for Area F.

RESOURCES CONSULTED:

Office of Academic Programs, EWS Area F Evaluation Committee.

DISCUSSION:

This GE Committee looked carefully at this course using the Area F Rubric (which is based on the CSU Breadth Requirement for Area F and CPP GE assessment requirements) and determined it was a model Area F course in Ethnic Studies. For Area F status, courses must comply with three of the five Core Competencies in Ethnic Studies developed by the CSUES Council along with the CSU Academic Senate and the Chancellor's Office. It was determined to address all five Core Competencies. It also satisfied all the GE requirements including meaningful effective written assignments, promotion of intellectual growth, and useful matrices for assessment. The GE Committee enthusiastically supports this course for inclusion in the Area F courses.
