TITLE OF REFERRAL: GE-024-201: PLS 2080: Introduction to Race and Ethnic Politics (New Area F)

BACKGROUND:

This is a new Area F course.

DISCUSSION:

This new Area F course from the PLS explores minority communities, citizenship, political values, attitudes, behaviors, and policy issues and representation in the United States. Emphasis on the experience of Native Americans, African Americans, Asian Americans, and/or Latina and Latino Americans, along with the overall immigrant experience in the US. The GE Committee examined it closely, and in consultation with the PLS Department suggested minor edits, which were completed. The GE Committee deemed this course to satisfy all the requirements for an new Area F course and passed it unanimously
