BACKGROUND:

Modified Area F course from a GE Area D3. For course information see Curriculog.

DISCUSSION:

This modified GE Area F course form an existing D3. The modification was significant, and the cross-listing with EWS is new, thus it is really a NEW GE course. While retaining a focus on place for the major, it shifts much content to address the Area F learning outcomes. It examines relationship between ethnic communities, specifically, Native Americans, African Americans, Asian Americans, and Latina and/or Latino Americans. It also examines their place in the United States. It also examines Interdisciplinary theories and practices of ethnic studies and place and a number of intersectional themes including place-based policies, systemic racism, racial segregation, gentrification, immigration, community activism, environmental and economic justice, immigration, and lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender and queer (LGBTQ) rights. The GE Committee determined that it met all the requirements for an Area F course unanimously.

RECOMMENDATION:

The GE Committee recommends Senate adopt GE-028-20: URP 1051: Ethnic Communities, Places, and Urban Planning (Modified Area F from D3).
