TITLE OF REFERRAL: GE-019-201: EWS 2041: Asian American Historical Experience (New Area F Course)

BACKGROUND:

Modified Area F course from a GE Area D3. For course information see Curriculog.

RESOURCES CONSULTED:

Office of Academic Programs, EWS Ethnic Studies Committee.

DISCUSSION:

This new Area F course from an existing EWS D3 course and needed some modifications to bring it into compliance with the Area F GE requirement. As is required, this course demonstrates and interdisciplinary and comparative study of race and ethnicity with special focus on four historically defined racialized core groups, with this one in particular focusing on Latina and Latino Americans. The course fulfills all the requirements in assessment, written assignments, and activities that promote intellectual or culture growth. The GE Committee unanimously passed this referral.

RECOMMENDATION:
