BACKGROUND:

DISCUSSION:

This new Area F Upper Division course from the SOC explores the ways in which Latina and Latino American communities have developed and the social, political, and economic structures that have influenced them. The course analyzes the ways in which hierarchical power relations and resistance to domination by Latina and Latino Americans have shaped their life chances across time and space in the U.S. and along the U.S.-Mexico border region. It is currently an upper division major course for SOC which was revised to meet Area F GE requirements. Since it already had upper division major status, Academic Programs determined that it should be included in the GE Committee's GE referrals at this time. The course complied with all Area F requirements and the GE Committee passed the course unanimously.

RECOMMENDATION:
