Ethnic Studies Requirement: Timeline

| August 17, 2020 | AB 1460 signed into law Requires 3-unit ethnic studies course taken by all CSU graduates Shall not increase units required for degree Commences with 2024 – 2025 graduates Catalog rights = Requirement must be in 2021 – 2022 catalog | |

| October 1, 2020 | CO to provide draft plan and learning outcomes Campus begins implementation plan | |
| November 2020 | Board of Trustees votes on changes to Title 5 CO provides final change details to campus | |
| December 2020 | Academic Senate approves changes to GE Academic Senate approves courses meeting the requirement | |
| January 2021 | 2021 – 2022 Catalog edited to include updates to GE | |
