Ethnic Studies - Graduation Requirement

- On August 17, 2020 Governor Newsom signed into law Education Code Section 89032 (also known as <u>AB 1460</u>) requiring a 3-unit course in ethnic studies as part of their CSU education.
- Can not increase units required to graduate
- Requirement must be met by students graduating in 2024-2025
- A recent report on the Advancement of Ethnic Studies recommended a GE requirement in Ethnic Studies
- New GE plan will include the creation of Area F and a 3-unit reduction to Area D (Social Sciences).
- Student learning outcomes are under development at the state-wide level.



Enrollment Management and Services

Registrar's Office

- 5,797 degrees awarded in 2019-20. Our second largest graduation class in campus history.
- CPP Connect launched a new Academic Planner for students to build their academic roadmap through their CPP career.

Admissions

- Admissions implemented a new Multi-Factor Admissions (MFA) evaluation process for Fall 2021 to evaluate First-Time Freshmen applicants.
- Welcomed our largest incoming Fall class of new Broncos with 4,331 first-time freshmen, 4,264 transfers and 855 graduate students.

Financial Aid and Scholarships

- 100% (\$15.49 million) of federal CARES Act I emergency grants were distributed to over 25,000 eligible CPP students.
- Cal Poly Pomona's default loan rate for our 2017 borrower cohort is an amazing 1.7%! (1.2% lower than 2019 and 2.5% lower than 2018.)



Student Success

- Decrease student to advisor ratios
 - Increase engagement
- Leverage planner data to anticipate course demand
 - Launched CPP Connect's Planner & Mobile App
- Remove institutional barriers and improve processes
 - All student-facing petitions and forms are now online
