• ASI Board of Directors 11/4

- Passed a proposal for the allocation of savings within the ASI budget for Basic Needs resources
 - 72%: Emergency Grant program
 - 14%: Poly Pantry
 - 5%: Laptop and hotpot request program,
 - 4%: ASI Basic Needs Scholarship
 - 3%: DACA support fees
 - 1%: Clothes Closet
 - 0.5% each to ASI's menstrual product pilot program and CalFresh Outreach.

• CSSA November Plenary

- o ASI President Yu introduced a resolution in favor of flexible grading options and continuing the suspension of portions of EO 1037 seen in Spring 2020
- Passed the Systemwide Affairs Committee but was not put on the agenda for the CSSA Board of Directors
- The CSSA BoD passed a COVID-19 Policy Agenda that includes a focus on basic needs resources, learning practices that ensure academic and holistic success, the health and safety of the campus community, and ensuring governance laws meet the virtual workspace
- The Legislative Affairs Committee is preparing for the 2021 CA Legislative Session

• ASI Board of Directors 11/18

 Passed a resolution formally denouncing Azerbaijan and standing in solidarity with Armenia through its recent crisis
