TITLE OF REFERRAL: ECS 1000: Child Growth & Development (Area E)

<u>BACKGROUND</u>: This is a request from the Early Childhood Studies department to modify an existing course and to propose it as a new GE Area E course. The course examines developmental theory including major milestones, typical and divergent, from conception through adolescence. The course aims to equip students as lifelong learners to think about development of themselves and others. Students will observe preschool and school age children, evaluate differences, analyzing characteristics of development at various stages.
