Academic Programs

Graduation Writing Assessment Requirement (GWAR) Revised Policy Effective Fall 2023

- Only applies to undergraduate students
 - GWAR is no longer a requirement for graduate students
- Students satisfy through completion of at least one 3-unit upper division course
 - Stand alone examinations are no longer allowed (i.e., no more Graduate Writing Test (GWT)
- Assess writing through WSCUC required campus learning outcome assessment process
 - Written Communication is a WSCUC Core Competency (CFR 2.2a)



Projected Enrollment and Yield Efforts

- Cal Poly Pomona ended CY 2021-22 at 19.8% above our CSU funded FTES target
- Projected resident enrollment for 2022-23: 21,722
 - 10.5% above campus CSU Target of 19,653 resident FTES
 - Enrollment plan: **3,100** first-time freshmen & **3,000** upper-division transfers
 - Fall Total Headcount Projection: **27,370**
 - Spring Total Headcount Projection: 24,697
 - Robust & coordinated yield efforts underway to achieve new student enrollment goals
