ARP: American Rescue Plan (HEERF III) Student Aid Distribution Plan

- HEERF III received on 6/23/21 provided a total of **\$85,115,294** - Student Portion is **\$42,594,664**.
- All enrolled students eligible, including DACA and International students.
- Requires that institutions prioritize students with exceptional need, such as students who receive Pell Grants.
- There will be four Phases of HEERF III Emergency Grants distribution from Summer 2021 to Spring 2022

Student Success

- Early Alerts

Fall 2020 – Spring 2021:

- Approx. 7,000 distinct students marked as needing support
- Interventions: emails, 1:1 meetings, tutoring, and escalation to the integrated care team
- Outcomes: Students who met with an OSS staff had higher term to term retention and a higher cumulative GPA compared with those that did not
