
# Safer Return COVID-19 Health and Safety Plan

The University's Safer Return COVID-19 Safety and Health Risk Mitigation plan reflects a multipronged approach reflecting three categories of risk mitigation:

- Personal measures individual behaviors to protect ourselves and those around us
- Administrative measures processes and policies that keep people safe
- Engineering measures physical measures put in place to help keep our campus safe

The **eight-pronged** approach reflects *evolving* public health orders and state requirements, best practices and scientific recommendations, and local conditions. Each mitigation together serves as multiple layers to improve our ability to keep our campus and communities safe. *The plan helps assure a safer return to campus requiring individual actions and shared responsibilities.* 






# **Points of Note**
