TITLE OF REFERRAL: PLS 3275/EWS 3275 – Asian American Politics (GE Area F)

**BACKGROUND:** This is a proposed new cross-listed GE Area F course from the Political Science Department and Ethnic and Women’s Studies Department. This course provides an interdisciplinary overview of Asian American politics and addresses the relationship between the racialization of Asian Americans and their political engagement. The course utilizes a variety of assessments, including exams with short essays, long essays, and in-class presentations, to assess satisfaction of GE Area F SLOs.
