TITLE OF REFERRAL: COM 2238/EWS 2238 - Racialized Language, Power, and Identities (GE Area F)

BACKGROUND: This is a proposed new cross-listed GE Area F course from the Communication Department and Ethnic and Women’s Studies Department. This course explores the role of language and communication in articulating, maintaining, and subverting historically shaped race relations and social processes which produce racial, class, social, and gender inequalities and stratifications. The course utilizes a variety of assessments, including quizzes, “metacognitive” notes, and a final project to assess satisfaction of GE Area F SLOs.

DISCUSSION: The GE Committee reviewed the course ECO to ensure that it satisfied the criteria for a successful GE Area F course, and we concluded that it satisfied these criteria and, thus, is a successful GE Area F course.
