TITLE OF REFERRAL: ENG 2185/EWS 2185 - Realities and Representations of La Frontera/The Border (GE Area F)

BACKGROUND: This is a proposed new cross-listed GE Area F course from the English and Modern Languages Department and Ethnic and Women's Studies Department. This course examines the historical, social, rhetorical, and political construction of borders and the realities and representations of and within borders from a multicultural and transnational perspective within the framework of globalization. The course utilizes a variety of assessments, including written responses, a critical analysis essay, a digital autoethnography, and a final group project, to assess satisfaction of GE Area F SLOs.
