TITLE OF REFERRAL: SOC 3315/EWS 3315 – Asian American Sociology (GE Area F)

BACKGROUND: This is a request from the Sociology Department and Ethnic and Women's Studies Department to modify an already existing course for inclusion as a cross-listed GE Area F course. The ECO has been significantly updated using an Ethnic Studies framework for cross-listing and to support GE Area F SLOs. The course examines the role of American militarism and colonialism on Asian immigration and racialization, as well as the neighborhood, community, school, and workplace experiences of Asian Americans, both historically and in the present day. It utilizes a variety of assessments, including exams and quizzes, short response paper, a term paper, and presentations, to assess satisfaction of GE Area F SLOs.

DISCUSSION: The GE Committee reviewed the course ECO to ensure that it met the criteria for a successful GE Area F course, and we concluded that it satisfied these criteria and, thus, is a successful GE Area F course.
